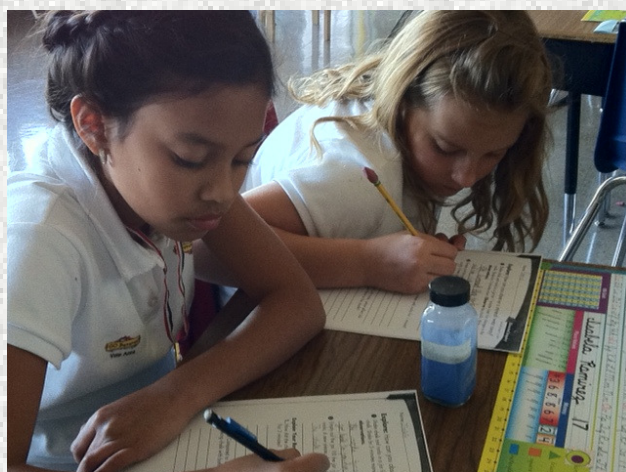


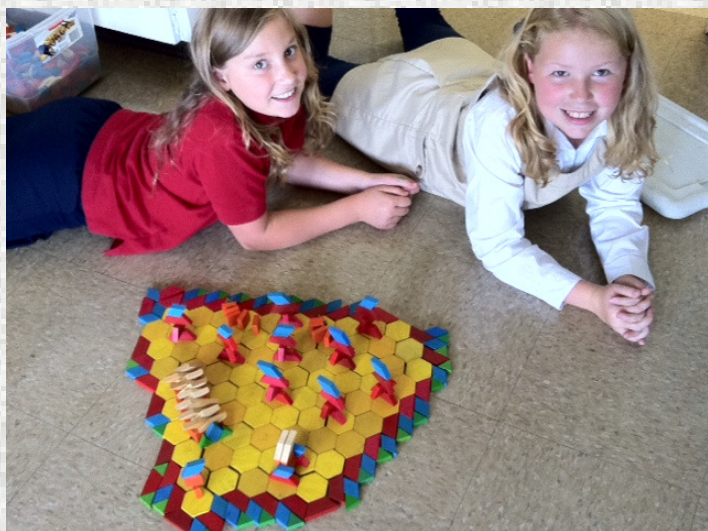
Going deep into learning...

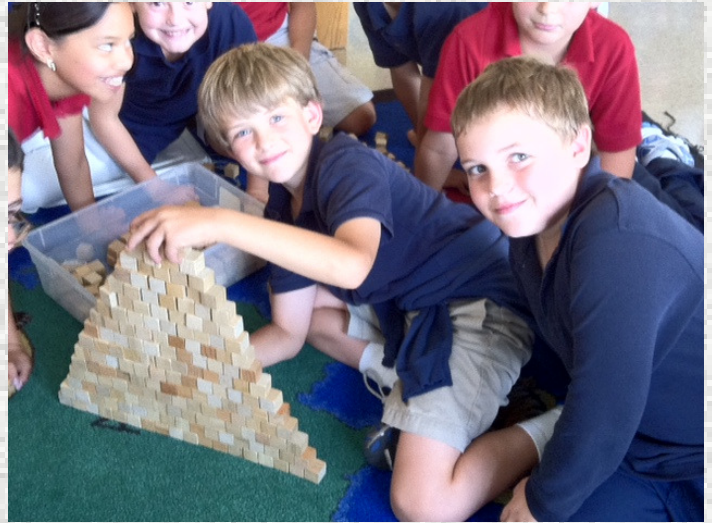


November/December Highlights

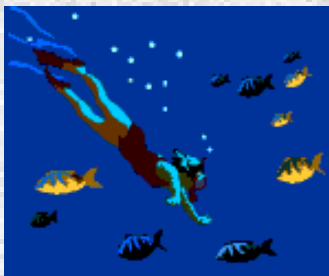
Region Reports and Maps - Each student is researching one of five regions of the U.S. including landforms, resources, history, early people, and places to visit. They will write a report and produce a map of the region.
